## riesling

often mistaken as a sweet wine due to australia's love of germany's mosels in the 70's, riesling is one of the great aromatic white varieties of the world. riesling can present differently depending on region, age and winemaking, bone dry, through to beautiful sweeter styles. australia's riesling character trends toward aromas of citrus and florals with a fresh and dry palate. riesling is wonderfully suited to an array of food types and is also a perfect aperitif.

## assyrtiko

assyrtiko is one of greece's signature white wine grape varieties, used for both dry and sweet wine. it reaches its peak on the island of santorini, where it was first planted. it yields a bone-dry, steely wine that has deliciously concentrated citrus aromas mixed with an earthy, mineral aftertaste. assyrtiko is the ideal complement to delicate dishes, fish, seafood and, surprisingly, even grilled meats

## malvasia

malvasia is an ancient family of grapes that includes a diverse collection of noble varieties. these grapes are capable of producing wine of any feasible color in dry, sparkling and sweet styles.

friuli-venezia-giulia is regarded as the best area where examples of dry malvasia is grown, showing light stonefruit flavors and a pronounced floral bouquet.

malvasia pugliese is instead brighter in colour with aromatic and floral notes, balanced by a light minerality

## albana di romagna

albana di romagna is a white wine from the south-western part of the romagne, northern italy. the heartland of the albana grape is a diverse area, expanding from the coastal zones of rimini and riccione to east of bologna, with an area of gentle hills sitting between the two.

the albana variety is fairly light bodied with good acidity and contains considerable residual sugar, resulting in its noteworthy ability to make a sweeter wine. it is usually produced in a dry style, with distinctive underlying peach and almond notes, a strong line of refreshing acidity and some complexity

## trebbiano

trebbiano is a refreshing, light-bodied white wine that has minimal aroma with subtle hints of lemon and stone minerality on the palate. it's generally dry and crisp and has a fruity flavour finishing with a bitter almond note. its easy-going qualities and medium alcohol content make it a very food-friendly wine, which is why it's the most common varietal in italy. the majority of trebbiano wines are made to be enjoyed young

## pinot bianco

pinot blanc (or pinot bianco) is a semi-dry white wine that is typically crisp and refreshing; it is very similar to a chardonnay in that it has a medium to full body, light flavor and high in acidity, which lends it a sour to tart profile. pinot blanc is lighter flavors often include citrus, melon, pear, apricot, and perhaps smokey or mineral undertones.

## garganega

## vernaccia di san gimignano

grown in hillside vineyards surrounding the tuscan town of san gimignano, this wine is made entirely from vernaccia grapes. vernaccia is straw yellow in color with gentle floral and citrus aromas and undertones of stone fruits and fresh herbs. this wine has flavors of lemon zest, sage, and minerality with hints of anise and almonds with a crisp finish.

## coda do volpe

coda di volpe is a white wine grape used to make medium- to full-bodied white wines since ancient times in campania, southern italy. the name coda di volpe means "tail of the fox", and was given about the variety's long, pendulous bunches of grapes, which resemble a fox's bushy tail. coda di volpe grapes are golden-yellow in color, as is the wine they make. the grape's aromatic profile leans towards the fruity (citrus and sometimes even slightly tropical) and spicy. it is not particularly high in acidity

# red wines

## schiaava

this grape variety had its first documented historical mention at the end of the middle ages, and it has played a central role in alto adige/südtirol winegrowing since the sixteenth century.

schiaava presents aromas of sweet cherries, red currants, raspberries and strawberries. added to this, there are often tones of almonds and violets.

the schiaava grape produces a light wine low in tannins, with moderate alcohol content and low acidity

## pinot meunier

pinot meunier is traditionally used in blend to produce sparkling wines. as still wine it has a deep ruby colour, a bouquet of dried rose petals and culinary spices. the palate is intense with cherries note and well balanced savoury spicy notes

## pinot noir

pinot noir traditionally presents slightly lighter than most reds delivering cherry and red fruit notes when young. other characters include spice, barnyard and toasty barrel notes which deliver greater complexity. there is nothing light about the structure of a well-made pinot noir as it gives up power, texture and a length of palate that rivals any red grape variety.

## morellino di scansano

morellino di scansano is a dry red wine from the coastal hills of southern tuscan in italy. one of the region's lesser-known docg wines. his style of sangiovese differs from its northern brethren due to the ripeness levels it can achieve in southern tuscan. the result is a rounder and more savory style of wine. regulations stipulate that at least 85% of the wine must be made from this variety, with the rest coming from other permitted tuscan red grapes. unlike many docgs, this wine does not require ageing and can be released in the march after the harvest, less than eight months later; logically, this wine is characterized by lively freshness and crisp character. other traits come in the form of cherry, pomegranate, plum, leather, cedar and spice notes

## chianti

historically associated with a squat flask enclosed in a straw basket, these wines are produced only in the chianti region of central tuscan. the recipe for chianti was created by baron bettina ricasoli in the middle of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and consisted of 70% sangiovese, 15% canaiolo and 15% malvasia. however, in 1995 the laws were changed so a chianti can be 100% sangiovese but must have a minimum of 80% sangiovese.

## montalcino

brunello di montalcino is a wine made with 100% sangiovese. it is a visibly clear, brilliant wine, with a bright garnet colour and it has an intense perfume, persistent, ample and ethereal character. one can recognize scents of undergrowth, aromatic wood, berries, light vanilla and jam.

to the palate, the wine has an elegant harmonious body, vigorous and racy, it is dry with a lengthy aromatic finish.

## montepulciano

vino nobile di montepulciano was designated italy's first docg wine in 1980, in an attempt to protect its traditional status and ensure its high quality. italian law requires that these wines be at least 70 percent sangiovese grapes (known in montepulciano as prugnolo gentile) and aged for a minimum of two years. the result is a rich, red wine with great depth of flavor and complexity, but still bright with notes of red fruit

rosso di montepulciano is made with the same sangiovese blend as vino nobile di montepulciano, with less-stringent aging requirements. lighter-bodied and ready to drink sooner than vino nobile, rosso di montepulciano still shares the classic flavor profile of the pricier wine

## tignanello

“this was the first sangiovese to be aged in barriques, the first red wine to be blended with non-traditional varieties (like cabernet) and one of the first chianti reds not to use white grapes. tignanello is a milestone. it is made from a selection of sangiovese, cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc. the wine is aged in barriques for about 12 months and for a further 12 months in the bottles.

the wine shows an intense nose of red fruit along with hints of sweet spices and underbrush. on the palate, the flavors are fresh and vibrant with supple and balanced tannins. the finish and aftertaste are long and sustained”

## giuseppe quintarelli

quintarelli's history evolved around the winery, which is located in cerè near the village of negrar. quintarelli's family has lived here since 1924. quintarelli's father, silvio, bought some land after world war i and established his own estate. giuseppe quintarelli started working on the estate in 1950, extended it and brought improvements in vine growing and winemaking. he experimented widely even while working within the region's traditions.

unfortunately, giuseppe quintarelli passed away in january 2012, aged 84, but his family continues to follow his vision and style. one of his four daughters, franca and her husband giampaolo grigoli manage the estate. giampaolo grigoli guided our steps through the winery and hosted our tasting. they have 10 hectares of vineyards with three hectares on the hill called monte ca' paletta next to the winery. they use the pergola veronese system for the local varieties (corvina and corvinone), and guyot for the international varieties (cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc and merlot). sustainable vine growing is at the core what they do.

at quintarelli there is an obsession about quality: from the product itself, to the quality of the corks, glass and bottle caps. the labels stand out with their charming and idiosyncratic handwritten style. they treat wine with respect and patience, allowing it to develop to its maximum potential before it is bottled. their wine doesn't come cheap. it is the most expensive in valpolicella, but it is heavenly

## barolo and barbaresco

notwithstanding the fact that both wines are produced with 100% nebbiolo, in neighboring areas less than 10 miles apart, there is still a distinct difference between the two. barbaresco ripens earlier than barolo, giving it a shorter maceration time, allowing it to be ready to drink earlier. however, this means it does not age as well. barolo takes a little longer to be drinkable but will age long into the future.
